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Acceptable Use of the Internet (Key Stage 2)

- A. At St Patrick's Primary School all pupils are responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet. This includes materials they choose to access, and any language they use.
- B. Pupils using the internet must not deliberately seek out offensive materials. Should any pupils encounter any such material accidentally, they are expected to report it immediately to a teacher.
- C. Pupils must not to use any inappropriate language in their email communications and contact only people they know or those their teacher has approved.
- D. Pupils must ask permission before accessing the Internet.
- E. School devices must only be used for schoolwork and homework unless permission has been granted otherwise.
- F. When appropriate, homework completed at home, and emailed to school
- G. Personal printing is not allowed (e.g. pictures of pop groups / television characters).
- H. Pupils must never share personal information such as telephone numbers and addresses on the internet.
- I. Pupils must never make arrangements to meet someone online unless this is part of an approved school project e.g. collaborate, zoom etc...
- J. Pupils consistently choosing not to comply with these expectations, will be denied access to Internet access in school.
- K. The Principal may check My computer files and may monitor the internet sites I visit.
- L. I understand that mobile phones are not allowed in class or during playtimes.
- M. If I need to bring my mobile phone to school, I need signed permission from my parent/carer and it must be left in the Principals office before 9.00am and be collected after school.
