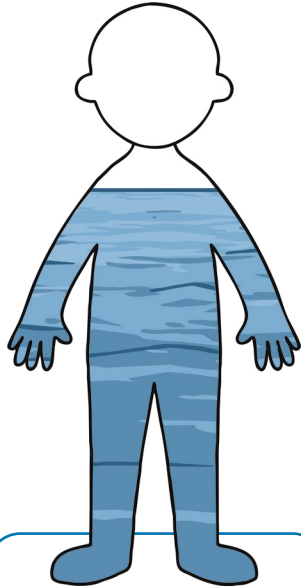


World Water Day 2022

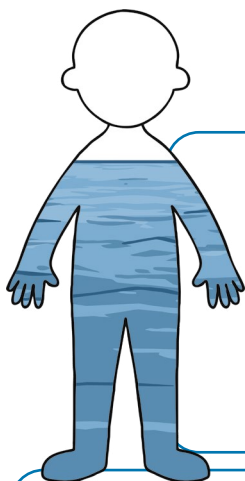
What Happens on World Water Day?

This Year's Theme

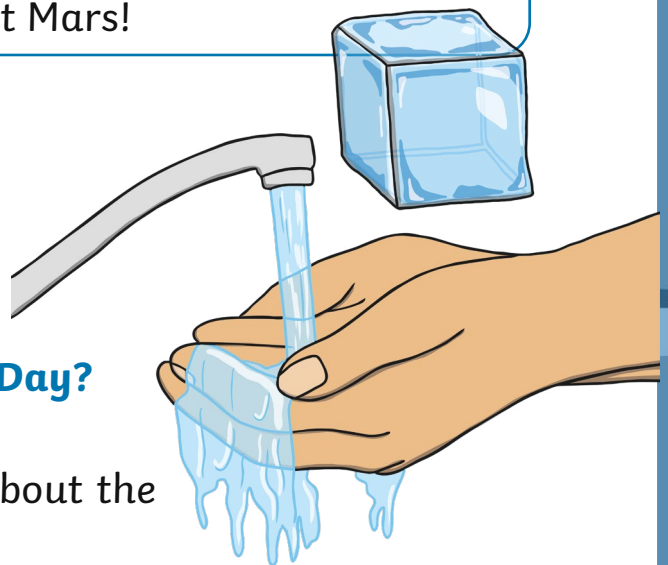
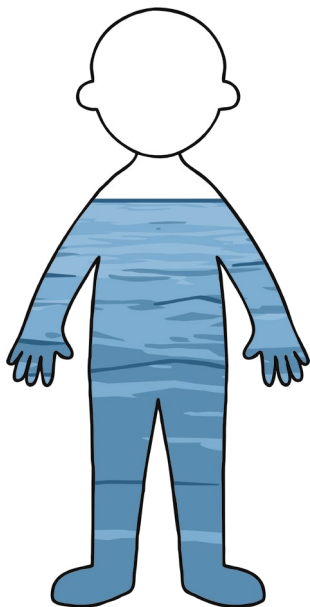
Each year, World Water Day has a different theme. The theme for 2022 is 'Groundwater: Making the Invisible Visible'.

- Solid water (ice) has been found on the planet Mars!



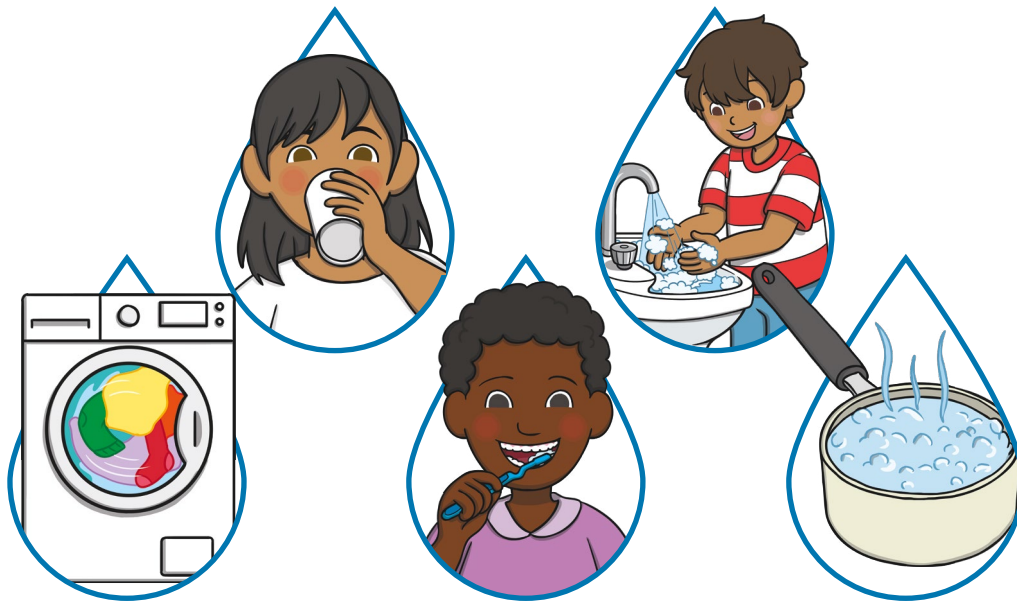
What Happens on World Water Day?
